

Josephine County Intergroup Business Meeting
May 21, 2026

Attendance: Joey, Mark, Jessica, John, Shawn, Amy, Glenna, Steve and Patty.

Meeting was opened at 7:03 PM with the Serenity Prayer.

Secretary Report: Jessica read the previous month's minutes that Patty took in Jessica's absence. Steve motioned to accept the minutes as read, Mark 2nd, passed unanimously.

Treasurer Report: Contributions for April totaled \$470, and other revenue from literature and event contributions were \$705.05. Expenditures were \$621.20 and other expenditures (chips and literature) were \$192.25 bringing the total net revenue to \$361.60. Mark redid the annual IRS confirmation and will do the Oregon SOS registration next month. Patty motioned to accept the treasurer's report as presented, Jessica 2nd, passed unanimously.

Literature Report: The Rogue Round-Up brought in record sales with 122 books being sold, and \$1578 in total income. The 5th edition Big Book will start presales in the fall.

Chair Report: No duties required the Chair's attention.

Office Manager Report: The office had 5 requests for meeting schedules, 3 requests for help, 18 literature sales, 12 coin/chip sales, 8 contributions, 21 drop-ins, and 13 miscellaneous phone calls. The hotline received 36 calls. There is currently one open shift at the office on Tuesday afternoons from 1-4 pm.

Web Servant Report: There were 1026 hits to the website, no new meetings and no closed meetings.

Jail Report: The jail meetings are running as usual; a meeting happened for both the men's and women's sides.
